

Heritage Point Association Swimming Pool Rules

WARNING: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

Heritage Point Association Members* who wish to use the pool must complete and sign a Pool Application. There is no charge for members to use the pool. The application must be approved by the Heritage Point Association. Members denied pool use may request a hearing with the Board of Directors. The Pool is a great amenity for all of us. Please be considerate and keep the pool area and bathrooms clean. Please pick up after yourself and use the trash can.

Pool use is reserved for members and their authorized guests. The Member must be in good standing with the Heritage Point Association (ie. HPA Assessment and/or HP Water Works billing up to date). There is no charge for guests. Members who, for any reason, have been denied use of the pool MAY NOT use the pool as guests of other Members. Members will be held responsible for their actions and the actions of their guests.

The Pool application can be found on the HPA website, www.heritagepoint.us, under Forms. Please complete the online application and you will receive an email upon approval. If you need a hard copy of the application, please contact the Pool Committee Chairperson.

Those Members whose application is approved will receive two (2) Pool Gate Key Cards for free (like a hotel access card or credit card). Any additional Pool Gate Key Cards can be requested through the Pool Committee Chairperson for a \$20 fee. These Pool Gate Key Cards will be used year over year, DO NOT discard them!

THE FOLLOWING ARE THE POSTED HERITAGE POINT SWIMMING POOL RULES:

1. Members are responsible for their children and guests.
2. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older. Only waterproof diapers are allowed in the pool. Please help keep the pool area clean.
3. Swim at your own risk. Swimming alone is prohibited.
4. Please shower before swimming.
5. Please do not swim if you have a cold, cough, inflamed eyes, infections or you are wearing bandages.
6. No Glass containers inside the fenced area or eating inside the pool.
7. No diving, running, pushing, dunking or rough play.
8. Safety devices are for emergency use only.
9. Please be considerate. No profane language or loud music. No intoxicated persons inside the fenced area.
10. No pets allowed in the pool area.

POOL HOURS:

The pool is open 7 days a week from 7am-Dusk. Dusk is defined here as the period of twilight between sunset and nightfall/complete darkness. It takes approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour from sunset to the end of dusk. Sunset varies everyday but is easily determined by looking it up online. The pool does not have lights and therefore swimming after nightfall is illegal.

AFTER HOURS TRESSPASSING AND VIOLATIONS:

Our pool rules are in place for everyone's safety. It is, as it has always been, the responsibility of the **MEMBER** to ensure their guests are following the rules.

If a **MEMBER** access card is used and a violation of our pool rules occurs (regardless of who is using the access card) a written warning will be issued. A second offense will result in the pool access card being deactivated. Reactivation of the card will require the member AND the violator appearing before the Board to petition reactivation.

If individuals are in the pool after hours, the above consequences will be enforced **AS WELL AS** the Sheriff's office being called immediately for trespassing.

If the pool is accessed without an appropriate access card it will be considered trespassing and the Sheriff's office will be contacted.

Any property damage/destruction will be referred to the Sheriff's office and prosecution of vandalism will be sought.

* Heritage Point Members are those persons who hold a legal or equity interest in a lot at Heritage Point. That is, your name must appear on the deed.

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
